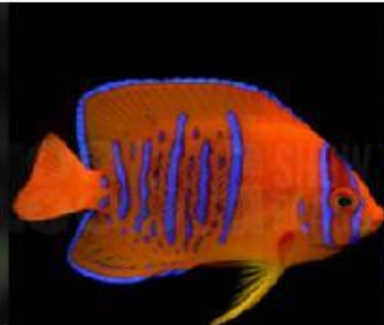
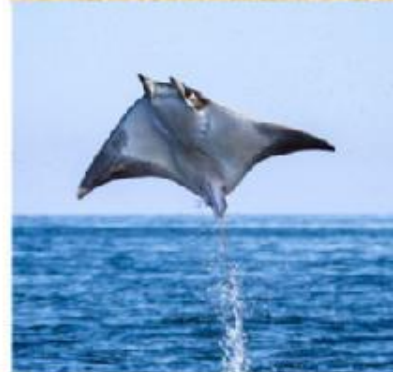

CITES COP17 context

CITES COP17 was held from 24 September to 4 October 2016 in Johannesburg, South Africa; 3.500 representatives, 183 State Parties as well as conservation experts and community representatives

SADC FANR and GIZ supported the development of a *common position* for SADC Member States.

- TFCA programme was chosen to showcase common linkages within the SADC region during the Conference, demonstrating what a landscape approach can mean for species conservation in the region.

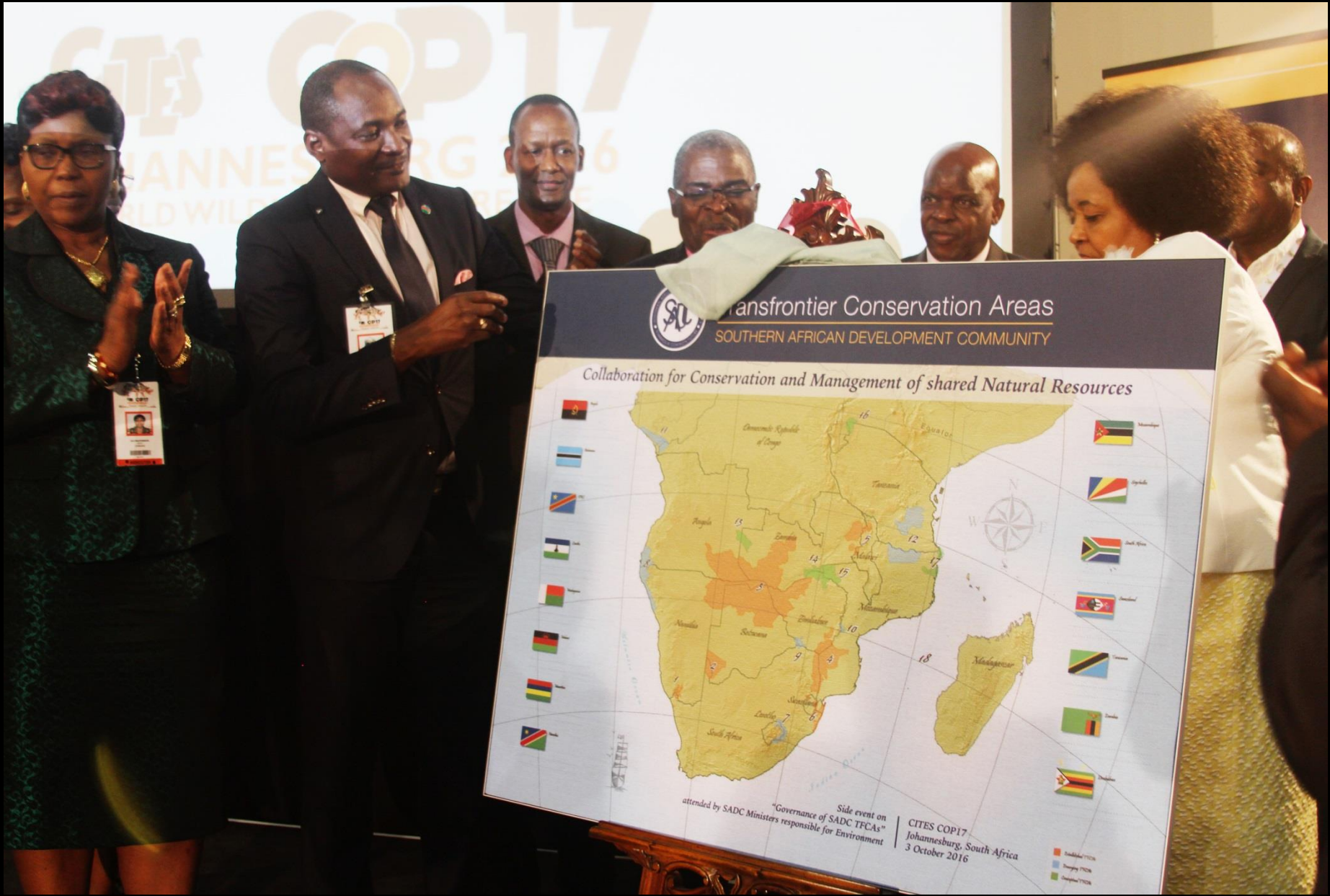
