Objective:
☐ To generate some basic data about current training priorities of SADC TFCAs
esearch Tool:
$oldsymbol{\square}$ step 1 (1.5 weeks): consolidation of idea and draft of questions
☐ step 2: (3.5 weeks): request to review TNA 2012 results sent, reminder but no replies
$\square$ step 3: mini survey (two pages) $\rightarrow$ 9 replies in 1 week

# **Response Rate**

Questionnaires sent out: 15 (SADC TFCA Focal Points,

TFCA Units / Coordinators)

Responses received: 9

Questionnaires returned: 7 (Angola, Malawi,

Botswana, Mozambique,

KAZA, Malawi-Zambia,

GMTFCA)

Submissions received in diff. format: 2 (RSA, GLTFCA)

Additional information received: 3 (KAZA, GLTFCA, Malawi)

Response Rate: 60%

### **Points for Consideration:**

- ☐ Limited time frame did not allow everyone to reply
- ☐ No or little opportunity for consultation
- $\Box$  Fairly good response rate  $\rightarrow$  Is training a priority?
- ☐ Selected tool not tested / space for improvement
- ☐ → It is preliminary data and far from comprehensive or complete, it is a 'pointer'
- ☐ → update to TNA may have to be taken up in a different format / on different scale

# **Some Results:**

- ☐ Respondents were asked to selected their top five training priorities out of a given selection of 28 training topics
- ☐ 7 respondents selected 5 each, one respondent selected 3
- ☐ Total of 38 votes for priority training needs in total

### **Conclusions:**

- □ Through simple questionnaire & personal follow some basic information was collated
   □ Different TFCAs/countries have different training priorities
   □ However, some training topics featured as priorities more than others: TFCA-specific, community-related, c-b law enforcement/anti-poaching, tourism (compare to guideline topics)
   □ Training desired should be in format of 'short courses'
   □ No funds available in TFCAs for trainings
   □ good foundation but follow up needed
   □ other questions that could be asked:
  - ➤ Is there expertise available in TFCAs that could be shared between TFCAs, rather than only relying on external training providers?
  - What priority does training have for TFCAs, compared to other areas that need attention?
  - Shall training be approached at TFCA or country level?
