


Background

- Established at Inception workshop, Sept 2013, in Jhb, RSA attended by 9 SADC MS
- In response to SADC TFCA Programme Component 4
 - Establishment of Data and Knowledge Management Systems
 - Information exchange, learning and innovation network which facilitates the gathering, processing and dissemination of TFCA related information








To overcome TFCA challenges through shared learning, knowledge management and collaboration







Open to all stakeholder groups

 Guided & led by a Steering Committee (SC) comprising TFCA Focal Points from all SADC MS + SADC Secretariat

Chairing of SC will change as per SADC Troika

 Members: renew their membership every 2 years – otherwise auto-lapse



1. Information exchange:

- Sharing experiences within and across TFCAs
- Conducting field visits to enhance understanding of local contexts

2. Joint learning and knowledge management:

- Developing a portal as a platform for joint learning, information exchange and knowledge management
- Developing a <u>regional</u> repository of TFCA related information
- Innovation and idea testing through joint experimentation and documentation
- Knowledge product development
- Enabling peer review and feedback

3. Resource mobilisation

4. Strengthening collaboration and relationships:

- Conducting face to face meetings
- Developing linkages with TFCA stakeholder groups
- Facilitating empowerment at the level of the TFCA



Main Characteristics:

- Over 250 members as registered through the online portal <u>www.tfcaportal.org</u>
- Representation from all SADC MS except Madagascar & Mauritius
- Almost 50% of members from government/parastatal institutions (lead agencies for TFCA development)
- Other representation NGOs, ICPs, Academia, private sector (including consultants)

- Face to face meetings
- Development of online communication platform for network members and a public website www.tfcaportal.org
- In country trainings on use of the portal South Africa, Namibia with attendance by Mozambique, Swaziland & Zambia
- Capacity building for portal administrators & online facilitators – TFCA International Coordinators & others
- Online moderated discussion with technical experts
