

Vision

SADC, a model of community centred, regionally integrated and sustainably managed network of world class transfrontier conservation areas.

Mission

To develop SADC into a functional and integrated network of transfrontier conservation areas where **shared natural resources are sustainably co-managed and conserved to foster socioeconomic development, and regional integration** for the benefit of those living within and around TFCAs and mankind at large.



Seven Components

1. Advocacy and harmonization

- 2. Enhancement of financing mechanisms for TFCAs
 - 3. Capacity building for TFCA stakeholders
 - 4. Establishment of data and knowledge management systems
 - 5. Enhancement of local livelihoods

6. Reducing vulnerability of ecosystems and people to the effects of Climate Change

7. Development of TFCAs into marketable regional tourism products

The history of the Network


• Established at Inception workshop, September 2013 (Johannesburg, RSA), attended by 9 SADC MS

In response to SADC TFCA Programme Component 4

- Establishment of Data and Knowledge Management Systems
- Information exchange, learning and innovation network which facilitates the gathering, processing and dissemination of TFCA related information




To overcome TFCA challenges through shared learning, knowledge management and collaboration










- Open to all stakeholder groups/individuals
- Guided & led by a Steering Committee (SC) comprising TFCA Focal Points from all SADC MS + SADC Secretariat
- <u>Chairing</u> of SC rotational as per SADC Troika, the current Chair is Namibia
- <u>Membership</u>: renew every 2 years – otherwise autolapse





1. Information exchange:

- Sharing experiences within and across TFCAs
- Conducting field visits to enhance understanding of local contexts

2. Joint learning and knowledge management:

- Developing a portal as a platform for joint learning, information exchange and knowledge management
- Developing a <u>regional</u> repository of TFCA related information
- Innovation and idea testing through joint experimentation and documentation
- Knowledge product development
- Enabling peer review and feedback

3. Resource mobilisation

4. Strengthening collaboration and relationships:


- Conducting face to face meetings
- Developing linkages with TFCA stakeholder groups
- Facilitating empowerment at the level of the TFCA



- Over 300 members have registered through the online portal <u>www.tfcaportal.org</u>
- Representation from all SADC MS except Madagascar & Mauritius
- About 50% of members from government/ parastatal institutions (lead agencies for TFCA development)
- Other representation NGOs, ICPs, Academia, private sector (including consultants)
